## **NEW ONLINE PORTALS!**

The Nebraska State Board of Public Accountancy (Board) is excited to introduce new online portals designed for Nebraska CPAs, registrants, and CPA firms. These portals will streamline the process for issuing initial permits to practice, handling renewals, and submitting Continuing Professional Education (CPE) reports.

In collaboration with its IT partner, Certemy, the Board has launched new online portal applications for initial issuance of Certificates, Permits to Practice along with Firm permits. These applications can be accessed directly on the Board's website at [www.nbpa.nebraska.gov](http://www.nbpa.nebraska.gov).

Dan Sweetwood, the Board's Executive Director, commented, "*The new Certemy platform for issuing initial Certificates and permits is just the start of our efforts to modernize applications, renewals, and other reporting processes. Our goal is to continue enhancing these portals throughout this year. Ultimately, we aim to provide CPAs with a seamless experience by allowing them to manage their accounts on Certemy, create passwords, submit and track the status of applications and renewals, and fulfill other reporting requirements efficiently.*"
