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BOARD REVOKES CREDENTIALS AND DISCIPLINES A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT (CPA)

Lincoln, Nebraska, May 8, 2009– The Nebraska State Board of Public Accountancy (Board) at their regularly scheduled Board Meeting on May 4, 2009 took the following action:

In the matter of Stacy L. Funk, Council Bluffs, Iowa, the Board accepted the surrender and revoked her Board issued Certificate (#6743) and her Active Permit to Practice (#23439) public accountancy. Ms. Funk was the subject of a recent felony conviction for theft in Douglas County, Nebraska.

In the matter of Michael T. Harrington, Lee's Summit, Missouri, the Board accepted the surrender and revoked his Board issued Certificate (#4912). Mr. Harrington was the subject of a felony conviction for theft from the federal government while employed by the General Service Administration (GSA) in Kansas City, Missouri.

In the matter of Joyce E. Borcher, CPA, Alliance, Nebraska, the Board agreed to the stipulation and consent order offered, whereby, Ms. Borcher was found in violation of Board regulations including lack of communication with a client. Ms. Borcher was placed on probation for two years and ordered to complete an additional 16 hours of continuing education beyond what is required.
