She is a graduate from the University of Nebraska at Omaha with a degree in Business Administration with an emphasis in Accounting. Ms. Stromp earned her master's degree in Business Administration from Creighton University. Ms. Stromp previously served as Chair of the Board's Enforcement Committee and is a member of the Education & Examination Committee. She also serves on the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy (NASBA) Nominating Committee.
