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State Board Removes Requirement for Display of Permits

Recent amendments to the Board's regulations in NAC Title 288, Chapter 7, eliminate the requirement for individuals practicing public accountancy to display their current permit to practice in a prominent location within their office.

In recognition of modern business practices and evolving workplace environments, the Board determined that this requirement no longer serves a practical purpose and places an unnecessary administrative burden on practitioners. The Board remains committed to regularly reviewing its regulations to identify and remove outdated or unnecessary requirements while ensuring appropriate standards for the profession.
