Experience Requirement amended by LB 56

The Nebraska State Board of Public Accountancy (Board) experience requirements within the Public Accountancy Act (Section 1-136.02) were recently amended by the passage of LB 56 by the Nebraska Legislature during their 2017 session. Later, Governor Pete Ricketts signed LB 56 into law. The change was initiated by the Nebraska Auditor of Public Accounts and the Nebraska Department of Revenue to allow accountants within their offices to obtain a permit to practice with two years of experience under the supervision of a CPA. This replaces the previous three-year requirement.
